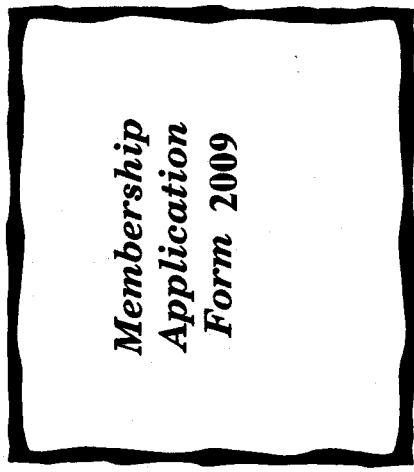
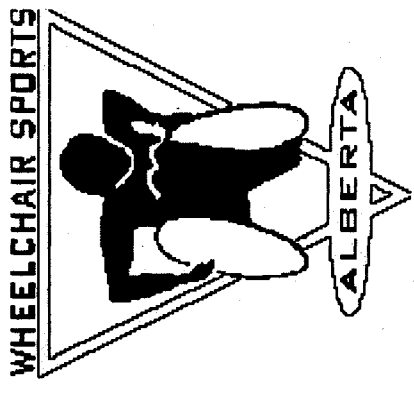

Membership Benefits Program

Wheelchair Sports Alberta is the Provincial Governing Body of wheelchair sports opportunities. Our mission is to facilitate sport opportunities for the organization and individual members, from the developmental to the elite level of participation, in the areas of athletic competition, technical development, leadership, and integration.

When you participate in a Wheelchair Sports Alberta program, you are guaranteed to receive the highest quality coaching and leadership available.

Membership is open to any individual athlete, club, official, coach or board member. Membership year begins January 1st and ends December 31st.

Membership benefits include:

All Sport Insurance Program

WSA provides affordable insurance for participants, executives and coaches. This coverage includes general accident and third party liability and covers all training and competition activities authorized by your Club.

Alberta Conference—CWBL

From October to April WSA coordinates and organizes the Alberta conference for the CWBL. Wheelchair basketball clubs from Grande Prairie to Lethbridge, compete

in mini tournaments playing towards the CWBL Finals in the spring.

Alberta Provincial Teams

These teams allow athletes an opportunity to showcase their skills through elite training and competitions at Regional and National Championships.

Annual General Meeting

All members 18 and older have full voting privileges at WSA's AGM held each year in April.

Equipment Loan Program

WSA loans equipment (wheelchairs, racquets, etc.) to developing junior and senior athletes to provide them with the proper equipment to reach their highest potential.

Fundraisers

Fundraising projects are available to any athlete, team, and club. They are easy to administer, with little or no upfront costs. They are fun and profitable.

National Coaching Certification Program (NCCP)

WSA is the only provider of the technical and practical components of the NCCP for coaches in Alberta. In cooperation with the CWBL, the CWSA, Athletics Canada, and the Coaching Association of Canada, courses of level 1 and 2 Technical can be held throughout the province.

Newsletters

WSA produces and distributes annual newsletters. They include information on wheelchair sports programs, tournaments, and other news from around the province and country.

Provincial Championships

Every year WSA organizes and hosts Provincial Championships for track athletes along with Athletics Alberta's Provincials. Events are offered for males and females in Track events and 10K race.

Resource Library

WSA has an extensive resource library available to all members.

Scholarship Program

WSA provides financial assistance to our top developing and elite athletes through the scholarship Program. Scholarships can be used for training and competition expenses, or equipment. Scholarships are awarded based on individual accomplishments at Provincial and National levels. Nationally carded athletes are ineligible for this program.

Training Assistance Program (TAP)

This program allows members to receive assistance in attending and coordinating workshops on becoming better at their sports.
